Great news!

Funding The National Lottery Heritage Fund has awarded the SWI a grant of £127,175 to complete and deliver the SWI Heritage Project.

Project Title Scottish Women's Institutes 'Preserving the Past to Inspire the Future'.

Project Timescale November 2024 – November 2026



Two new roles

- A qualified part-time Heritage Manager To manage and deliver the project on time and on budget
- A part-time Volunteer Coordinator To engage and work alongside volunteers
- Associated costs Laptops, equipment, IT/tel/office overheads



Archiving

- Project Archivist Based on 12 months' support (one day a week) straddling Year One and Year Two
- Digital Outputs Digitisation of archives
- Expenses for Volunteers Based on 70 volunteers



Oral Histories

- Digital Outputs
 - Digitisation of recordings
 - 10 Podcasts
- Expenses for Volunteers Based on 150 volunteers per year



Other

- Training for Volunteers Additional online sessions
- Events Intergenerational craft workshops for young women
- Contingency 10% of total budget
- Evaluation Report External evaluation



What we are match funding

- Website Develop and design a new SWI website to showcase the SWI Heritage Project including areas for accessing the archives and oral histories
- **Events** Deliver a third sector sharing event, showcasing the learnings and successes of the project
- Ad hoc staff time To ensure project's success
