- 1. The competition is open to individual SWI members (it is not an institute effort)
- 2. Only one entry per member is permitted in each class.
- 3. All the entries must be the original work of the competitor, not kits or copies are permitted.
- 4. The entries must not have been exhibited in a previous SWI National Competition.
- 5. If you want insurance cover for you entry/entries, you must arrange this yourself.
- 6. The three classes and themes are as follows:

- 7. Oils/Acrylics painting must be framed unless using box canvases must be mounted. Framing is strongly recommended where possible for all entries. All entries must be able to be hung at the Exhibition.
- 8. The maximum size of painting is where the length of all four sides are added together should not exceed 240cm, this includes all mounts and frames, e.g. 60cm by 60cm, 40cm x 80cm etc.
- 9. The entries will be displayed at an Exhibition in the Beach Ballroom, Aberdeen and can be collected from there. If you wish your entry to be returned by post, return postage must be included with your entry. Any entries not collected from the Exhibition will be brought back to HQ and can be collected from there.
- 10. The entries, whether hand-delivered or posted, must be enclosed in strong re-usable packaging (suitable for transportation between HQ and the Beach Ballroom) and sent or delivered to HQ by the closing date of Friday, 26th July 2019. (delivery and collection is the responsibility of the entrant)
- 11.A non-returnable entry fee of £3.00 *per class* is payable on return of the entry form. Payment options are as follows:
