'Oranges & Lemons'

The entries will be displayed at the Exhibition at the H & H Conference at the Beach Ballroom, Aberdeen on the 10th & 11th of September 2019

Eligibility

1. This Competition is open to all Institutes but only one entry per Institute will be accepted. Two Institutes in the same Federation may join together and submit a joint entry.
2. Only five items will be accepted.
3. A minimum of four members must take part.
4. All articles must have been made by members since the 2016 H & H Conference in Perth.
5. This Competition is to show as wide a range of crafts as possible.

Procedure

1. The items to be made and exhibited, with the marks allocated for each, are as follows -

Article	Total
(a) Embroidered article	20
(b) Knitted article	20
(c) Sewn article including patchwork articles.	20
(d) Own Choice	20
(e) Own Choice	20
Co-ordination: Variety of Crafts – 5; Appearance – 5; Interpretation of theme – 5	<u>15</u>
Total	<u>115</u>

The Co-ordination mark out of 15 will be awarded to each Institute entry before the articles have been individually judged.

2. **A maximum area approximately one square metre** will be allowed to display the articles. The area will be covered in a Royal Blue drape. Please consider size of articles for this space. It is not possible for an Institute to display its own entry.
3. Each Institute will be responsible for their entry, suitably packed in boxes for onward transporting, being delivered to **SWI Headquarters, 42 Heriot Row, Edinburgh** either by hand or post and to arrive not later than **26th July 2019**. SWI cannot be held responsible for an entry arriving damaged or late.
4. If you want insurance cover for your entry/entries, you must arrange this yourself.
5. Headquarters will arrange for the unpacking and repacking of entries at the time of judging. Arrangements will also be made by Headquarters to transfer the entries to the exhibition and for displaying them.
6. An Entry Fee of £10.00 (incl. VAT) should accompany the attached Entry Form which should be returned to SWI Headquarters, 42 Heriot Row, Edinburgh EH3 6ES not later than **26th July 2019**. **No late entries will be accepted**. If you wish your entry acknowledged, please send SAE. If the Institute has not received further details including tags by dates? please contact Headquarters.
7. Judges, whose decision will be final, will be appointed by the H&H Committee.
8. Prizes will be awarded as follows -
 - a) 1st Vaughan Nash Silver Medallion
 - b) 2nd Vaughan Nash Bronze Medallion
 - c) The Nancy Macmillan Trophy will be awarded to the highest placed article out with the winner or runner-up.
