The format of the Matter of Opinion Competition and National Quiz has changed for 2020, due to Government restrictions.

SWI National Matter of Opinion Competition

- Teams will consist of four people, including a team member that will be appointed as the Chairman. The Chairman will be the main point of contact and must provide an email address for correspondence.
- The entries from each team will be pre-recorded. A Zoom meeting will be scheduled for a suitable date and time and the list of seven questions will be issued (by email) to the Chairman 60 minutes before the Zoom Meeting is due to take place. This will give the team the opportunity to discuss the questions that have been presented before the recording begins.
- Each set of questions will be given a designed letter – i.e. 'Questions A' and each team will get the opportunity to pick a set of questions preceding the Zoom meeting.
- If you wish, we can set up a practice Zoom Meeting for you prior to the official recorded meeting and give you a test question. If you would like to do this, please email educ.int@theswi.org.uk
- On the date of the competition, the pre-recorded entries will be shared with the audience and the adjudicator. The Adjudicator will get the opportunity to prepare his feedback whilst the National Quiz is taking place. Once the Competition is completed, the Adjudicator will give his feedback and declare the winner.

The SWI National Quiz Competition

This will take place directly after the Matter of Opinion Competition

Due to Government Guidelines the National Quiz will proceed online this year. Again, we will be using Zoom Conferencing.

The Quiz will go ahead on a 'Just for fun' basis. There will be eight rounds of six questions and the answers will be given once the quiz is complete. We will rely on you to mark your own answers and give your final score at the end of the quiz. Any SWI member can participate. The only items you will require will be a pen and some paper.
