Rules

- 1. RCCC rules apply, including the Free Guard Zone and use of curling sticks. (Please ensure you have a copy of the current Rule Book).
- 2. Any federation having four or more teams taking part at the federation round will be entitled to send their winner and runner-up to the competition.
- 3. The draw is made by the host federation. In the event of an uneven draw the host federation will be asked to provide a non-competitive team.
- 4. Teams do not have choice of stone colours as the names are already up.
- 5. All games 8 ends or two hours.
- Score will be two points for a win. If there is a draw, the winner will be decided by the greater number of ends won and if still drawn, winner will be decided by drawing the shot.
- 7. After first round the teams are split into two sections: winners play winners in the High Road and losers play losers in the Low Road.
- 8. In the event of an uneven number of rinks, the lowest winner plays the highest placed loser.
- 9. The same two rinks do not play each other again.
- 10. The overall winner is decided by most points In the event of a tie shots up Followed by number ends won If teams are still tied then overall shots count.
- 11. Winner of the Low Road is decided with most points In the event of a tie – shots up Followed by number ends won If teams are still tied then overall shots count.

Other Relevant Information

- 12. Engraving of Trophy Headquarters will reimburse cost of engraving. Please send claim with receipt for engraving to Headquarters within 6 weeks of the event.
- 13. For the 2018 competition, if your federation has not opted for the Action Appeal Grant, Headquarters will refund 100% of travel expenses if the expenses claim is received within 28 days from the event. **Travel expenses will be paid for a team of four competitors.**
