Monday, 2nd May

You will depart by coach from the local pick-up points, Edinburgh, Glasgow and Gretna. There will be a stop en-route for refreshments (not included) and thereafter you will head directly to the Cotswolds, with a stop in the historic town of Lichfield. Due to the length of the journey, this stop will only be for 60-90 minutes. This will allow you to arrive at the Stratford Manor Hotel by 6pm



Tuesday, 3rd May

Take a tour of some of the Cotswold Villages with the opportunity to enjoy the 'Tuesday Market' in Moreton-in-Marsh. The coach will then take you to visit other historic villages:

Stow-on-the-Wold
Burton-on-the-Water
Broadway

Wednesday, 4th May

Travel to the outstanding Blenheim Palace, birthplace of Sir Winston Churchill, where you can discover 300 years of history at one of Britain's greatest palaces. There are stunning formal gardens, the Palace State Rooms and the Churchill exhibition to see.

In the afternoon, you will travel to Oxford.



Thursday, 5th May

In the morning you will travel to the birthplace of William Shakespeare, Stratford-Upon-Avon.

This will give you the opportunity to look around this 800-year-old market town

In the afternoon, you will travel to Warwick Castle. The Medieval fortress has a host of events from story telling to live shows. Whether you are looking at the view from the Towers & Ramparts or visiting the dungeons where the prisoners were kept, there is plenty to see and do.



Friday, 6th May

Depart homeward after breakfast with comfort stops in Newbank Garden Centre, Newton-le-Willows and Gretna.

There will be drop off points at Gretna Services, Edinburgh and Glasgow.
