Team Structure

- Each team consists of **three players**.
 - Entry fee: **£60 per team**
 - Federations may hold their own local heats to select their team (optional).

Gameplay Format

- The competition will take place on **one outdoor bowling green**.
- There will be **four games** in total.
- Match timings will be provided in the official draw issued by SWI Central Office.
- Standard outdoor bowling rules apply.

An official adjudicator/umpire will oversee scoring and rule queries.

What to Bring

- Regulation outdoor bowls
- Appropriate flat-soled bowling shoes
- Weather-appropriate outdoor clothing
- Money for raffle or refreshments (optional)

Scorecards will be provided.

On the Day

- Arrive in good time for registration.
- Listen for announcements about game times and green allocations.
- Respect the venue's rules and etiquette.
- Follow any guidance given by the adjudicator or stewards.

Travel & Expenses

- SWI Central Office no longer reimburses travel expenses.
 - Federations are encouraged to support competitors with travel or entry costs where possible.
