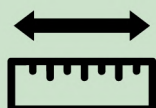

A beautiful, segmented hat
with twisted cable detail,
knit in the round

The SWIsh hat is knit in the round from brim to crown. It features a twisted cable detail that travels up the hat, made without a cable needle.

Sizes: Baby (Child, Adult)

Fits head approximately 16 (19, 22.5)" or 40 (48, 57) cm diameter.

Note: Finished size is smaller to provide a snug fit and stretch out to showcase the cable pattern.

Yarn: 110 (150, 210) m of DK weight yarn.

Gauge: 22 sts & 30 rounds to 4" or 10cm on larger needles.

Suggested needles: 3.5mm, 4mm (or as required to meet gauge)

You will need either DPNs, a long circular for magic loop or 16" or 40cm circular for the child and adult sizes.

Notions: Darning needle, stitch marker for BOR.

Abbreviations:

BOR – beginning of round

C2F – cross 2 front (Knit into second st on left hand needle, then knit into the first st and take both sts off left needle).

dec - decrease(d)

DPNs - double pointed needles

k - knit

k2tog - knit 2 stitches together

p - purl

p2tog - purl 2 stitches together

PM - place marker SM - slip marker

Rep - repeat

st(s) - stitch(es)

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Pattern

Using smaller needles, cast on 78 (90,102) sts.

PM for BOR and join for working in the round. SM as you come to it.

Work in 1x1 rib (k1, p1) for 0.75 (1, 1.5)".

Change to larger needles.

Round 1: *K9 (11, 13), p1, k2, p1; rep from * to end.

Round 2: *K9 (11, 13), p1, C2F, p1; rep from * to end.

Work rounds 1- 2 until piece measures 4 (5.5, 6.5)" from cast-on, ending on round 1.

Crown decreases: Switch to DPNs when there are too few sts to work comfortably on circular needles.

Round 1: *K to 2 sts before first purl st, k2tog, p1, C2F, p1; rep from * to end. [6 sts dec, 72 (84, 96) sts]

Round 2: *K to first purl st, p1, k2, p1; rep from * to end.

Work rounds 1-2 another 5 (6, 7) times. [30 (36, 42) sts dec, 42, (48, 54) sts]

Next round: *K to 2 sts before first purl st, k2tog, p1, C2F, p1; rep from* to end. [6 sts dec, 36 (42, 48) sts]

Next round: *K to 2 sts before purl st, k2tog, p1, k2, p1; rep from * to end. [6 sts dec, 30 (36, 42) sts]

Sizes – (Child, Adult) only: Rep last 2 rounds until there are 30 sts remaining.

All sizes

Next round: *P2tog, k2, p1; rep from * to end. [6 sts dec, 24 sts]

Next round: *P2tog, k1, p1; rep from * to end. [6 sts dec, 18 sts]

Next round: *P2tog, p1; rep from * to end. [6 sts dec, 12 sts]

Next round: *P2tog; rep from * to end. [6 sts dec, 6 sts]

Cut yarn, leaving an 8" tail, draw through remaining live sts and pull to close and secure the top of hat and fasten off. Weave in your ends and block your hat by hand washing and laying it flat to dry, gently shaping the hat.
